



## 1977 CARS UP-ENDED IN RAIL WRECKS

A number of cars turned skyward in these wrecks. The rail car in the top photo looks like it's performing a balancing act. It was one of 23 cars on a Rock Island freight that derailed west of Eldon, Mo., as reported previously in **LABOR**.

In the middle photo, a caboose up-ended after a collision between a Conrall locomotive and a line of halted work cars on the West Shore main line near Nyack, N.Y. The engineer on the locomotive and three employes of the work train were injured and treated at a Nyack hospital.

In the bottom photo, the car pointed upward was one of 19 cars derailed on the Chicago & North Western near California Jct., Ia. The car belonged to the Raritan River Railway of New Jersey.
